

NOTICE OF LAST DAY OF REGISTRATION  
FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON  
TUESDAY, MAY 8, 2018 IN ST. JOSEPH COUNTY, MICHIGAN

An election will be held in St. Joseph County on Tuesday, May 8, 2018. The last day to register for the election is **April 9, 2018**. Persons residing in the County registering after the deadline will not be eligible to vote at the election.

Persons planning to register may do so in person at the City or Township Clerk's Office, the Secretary of State drivers license bureau, or County Clerk's Office during regular business hours. Registration may also be made at the specified agency for clients receiving services through the Human Services Department, the Department of Community Health, Michigan Works, and some offices of the Commission for the Blind and at the military recruitment offices for persons enlisting in the armed forces. Registration by mail may be used by obtaining and completing a Mail Voter Registration Application at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote) and forwarding to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. Lastly, those already registered may update their voter registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

Persons entitled to be registered voters must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the election: (1) a citizen of the United States; (2) not less than 18 years of age; (3) a resident of the State of Michigan and township in which they are registering for not less than 30 days prior to the election. In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the election.

The St. Joseph County residents will be voting on a 911 SERVICES MILLAGE QUESTION.

The White Pigeon Township residents will be voting on a MILLAGE PROPOSAL.

The White Pigeon Community Schools District will be voting on an OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL.

ST. JOSEPH COUNTY EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICES  
(911 SERVICES) MILLAGE QUESTION

For the purpose of funding a comprehensive, county-wide 911 emergency telephone and dispatch system, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of St. Joseph, Michigan, be levied at 1 mill (\$1.00 per thousand dollars of state equalized assessed valuation) for a period of seven years, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025 inclusive? This millage would generate an estimated revenue of \$1,938,168 the first year the millage is authorized and levied.

White Pigeon Township  
Millage Proposal

Shall White Pigeon Township impose an increase of up to 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 10 years, 2018 through 2027 inclusive, for general township operating purposes, which 2-mills increase will raise an estimated \$389,860.00 in the first year the millage is levied.

WHITE PIGEON COMMUNITY SCHOOLS  
OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 19.4828 mills (\$19.4828 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in White Pigeon Community Schools, St. Joseph and Cass Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 6 years, 2019 to 2024, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2019 is approximately \$2,699,560 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy)?
